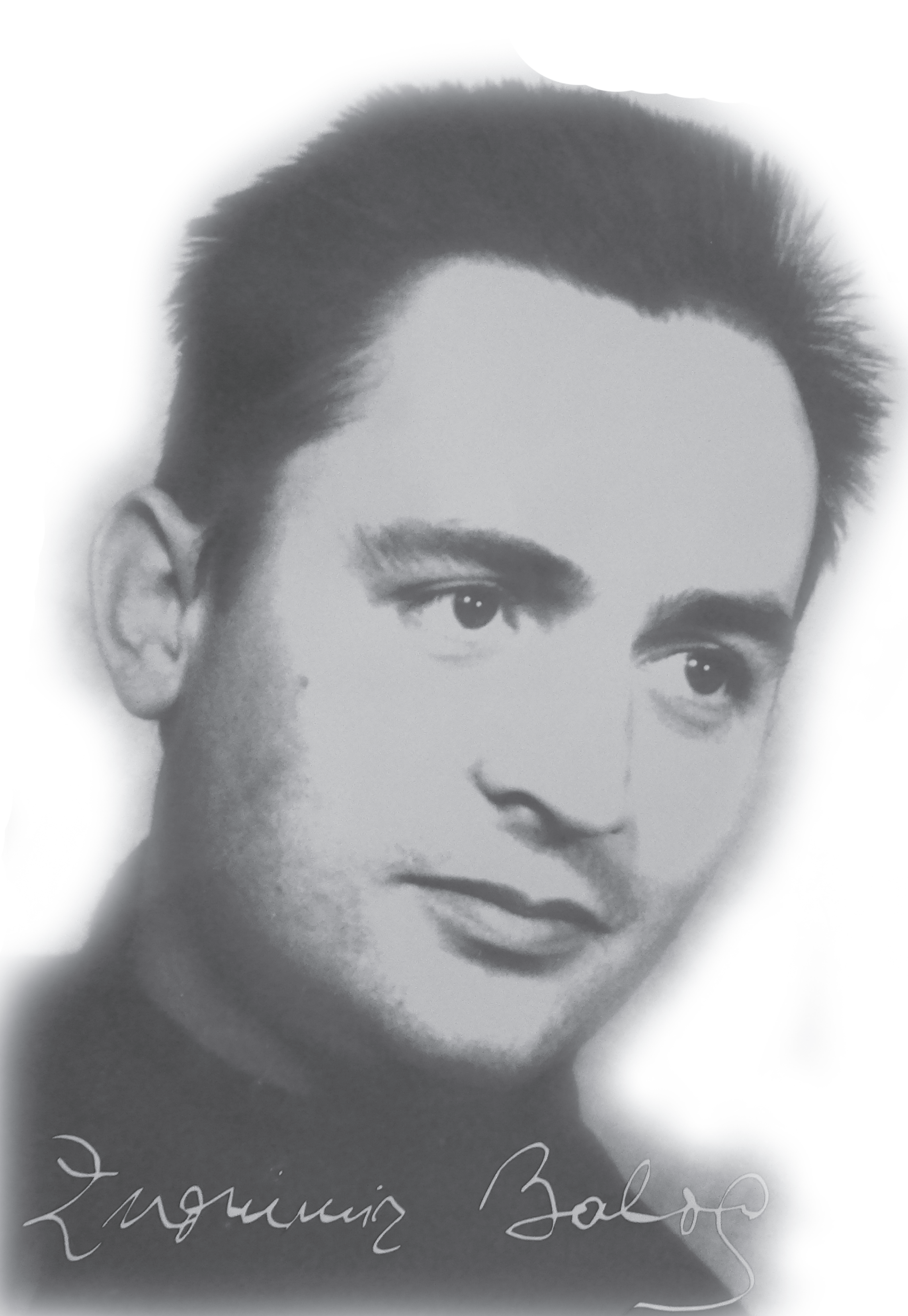


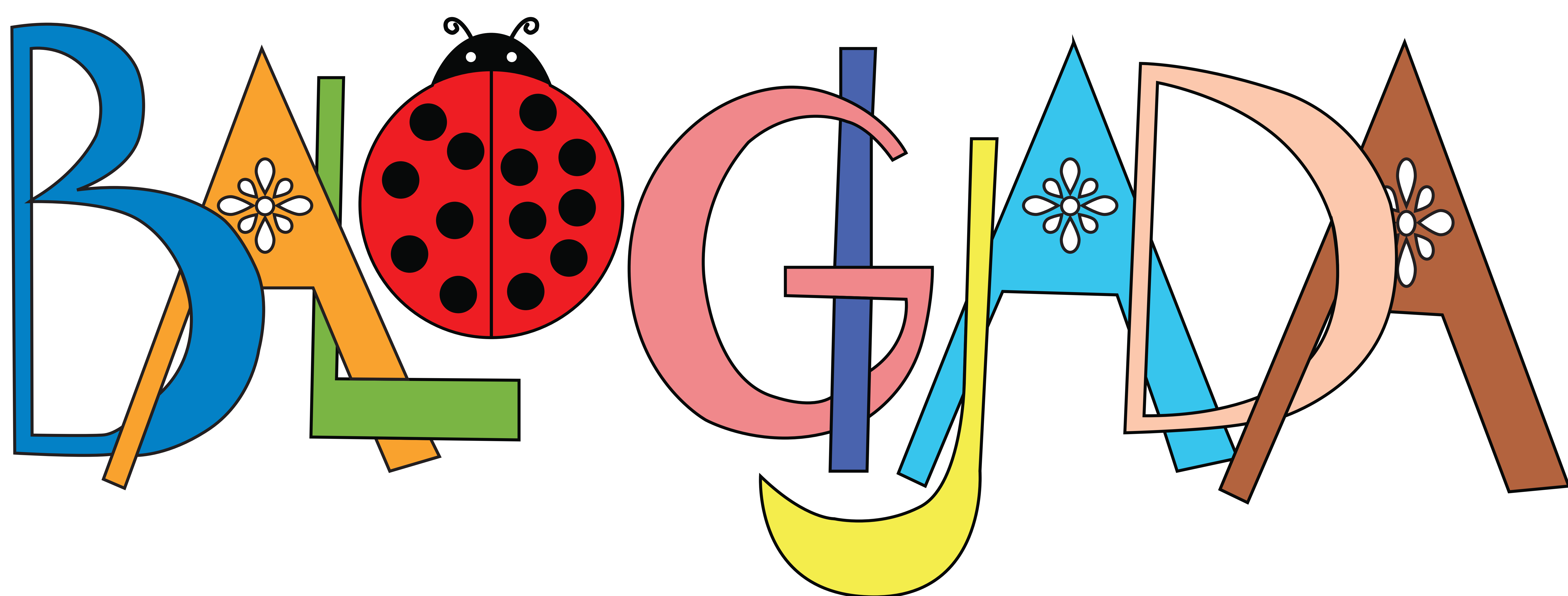


Zvonimir Balog

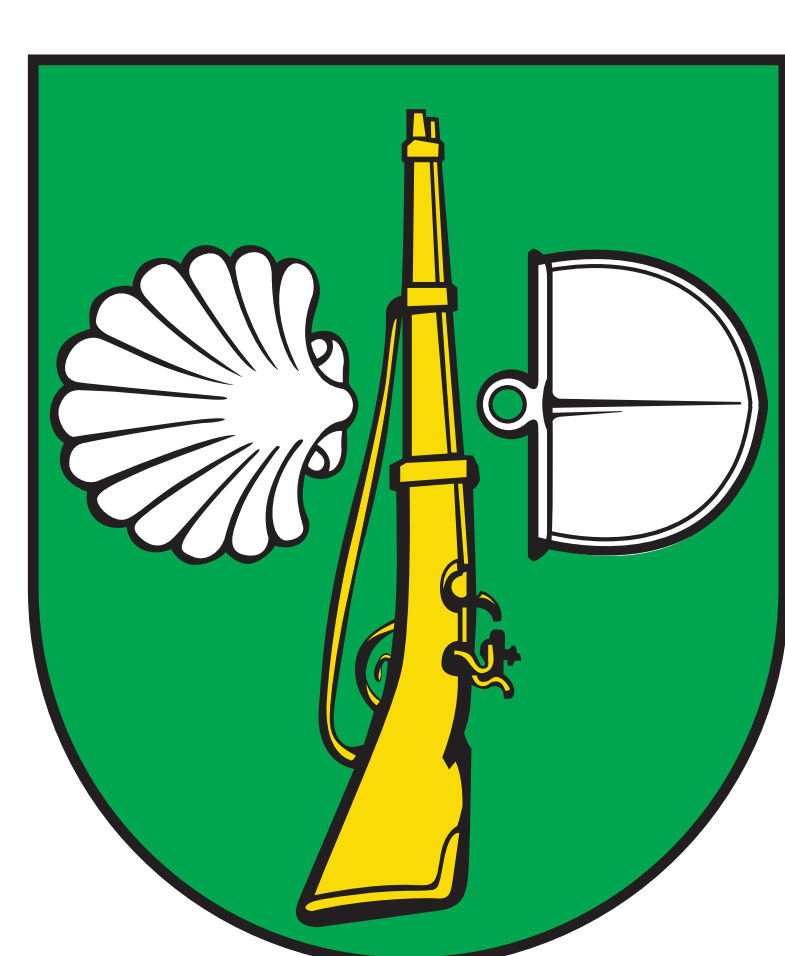

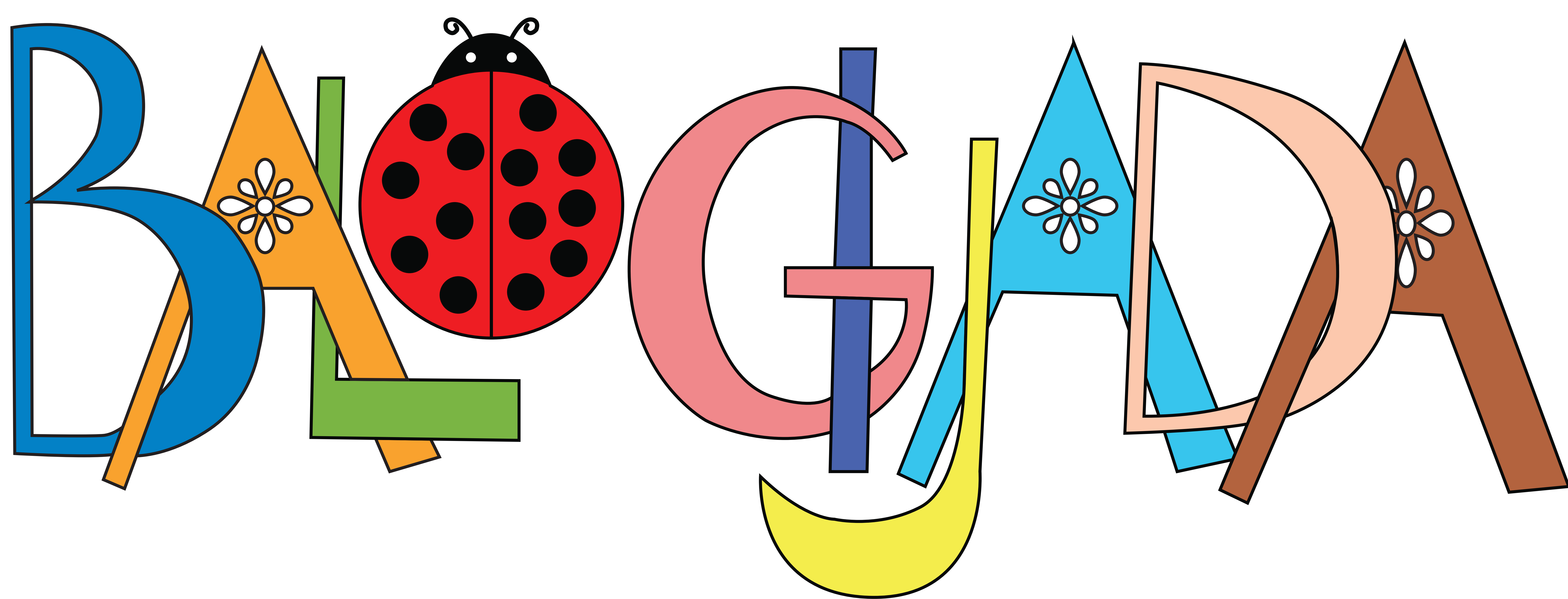


Zvonimir Balog

(Sveti Petar Čvrstec, 1932. - Zagreb, 2014.)

The most awarded Croatian writer for children, a founder of modern Croatian children's poetry, painter, sculptor, illustrator, and art pedagogue.

He is an author of about 90 books and picture books, translated into 20 foreign languages, a participant in 60 art exhibitions, editor of children's magazines Smib and Modra Lasta as well as an editor of the Children's programme of HRT (Croatian Radio Television).



Balogijada is a national competition in categories of art and recitation for students of Croatian elementary schools.

Every year, there are hundreds of students participating from all over Croatia, and the final ceremony is held in June in Balog's birthplace Sveti Petar Čvrstec.

The organizer is "Grigor Vitez" Sveti Ivan Žabno Elementary School where Zvonimir Balog worked as an Art teacher from 1958 to 1967.

Aims of Balogijada

Encouraging children's scenic and art creation to develop children's imagination and creativity as a starting point in creating an original, ambitious, and inventive young people. Furthermore, to promote Balog's poetry based on the word game, creativity, luddism and nonsense, optimism, and humour.

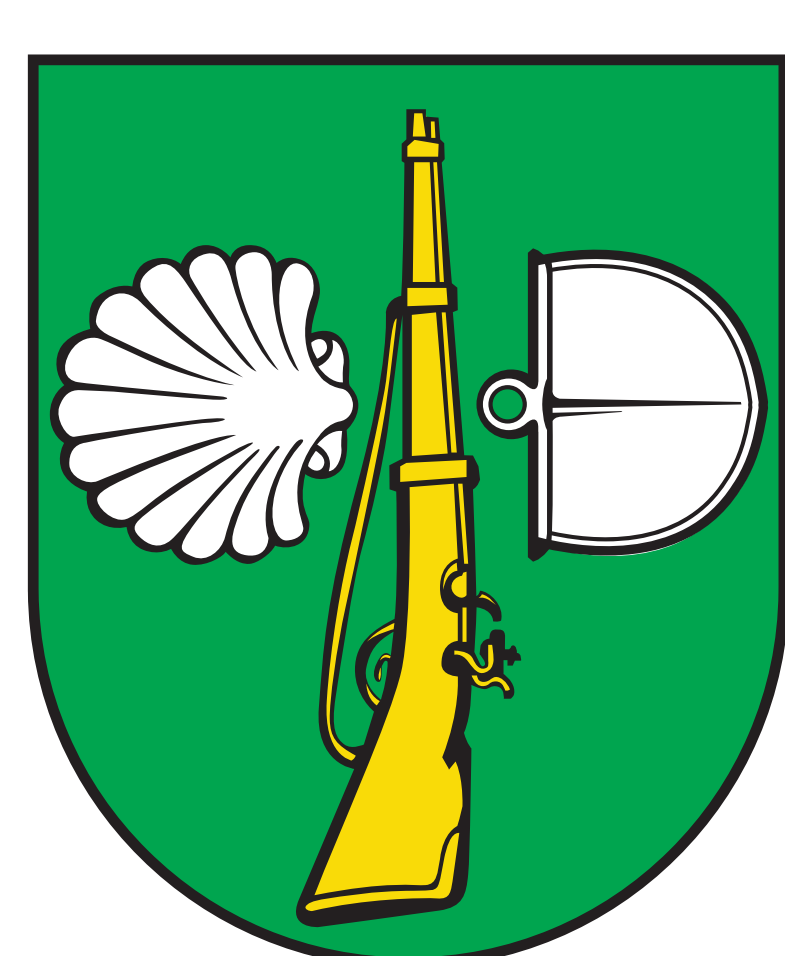


Balogijada can be a huge contribution to a local community and local region that could result in making a network of events that will establish the importance and potential of a successful project like this one all over Croatia.
